Training Programme	Contents	Duration
Volunteers Learning Programme	Adult social care. Their role and responsibilities. Whistleblowing. Equality, diversity and person centred values. Telephone support and communication. Pain and discomfort. Infection prevention and control. Food safety. Fluids and hydration. Health and safety. Stress.	Half day + Tutor support
Full Training package (new recruits or workers returning to the sector)	Care certificate knowledge. Assisting and moving people. Basic life support. Fire safety. Food safety. Health and Safety Awareness. Infection Prevention and Control. Safeguarding (specially around isolation). Medication	5 days + Tutor support
Assisting and moving people	This safe moving and handling people training course aims to help reduce the risk on injury to both staff members and the services user when performing people moving & handling techniques in the workplace. The course will identify best practice and correct technique as well as highlighting bad practice and condemned moves.	60mins + Tutor support
Basic life support	This basic life support training course aims to help teach staff a basic knowledge of first aid – covering CPR, recovery position, bleeding, choking and shock. The course will allow staff to confidently respond to minor accidents and incidents within the work place. The course can be tailored to suit any audience and is suitable for both complete novices or those looking to refresher their basic first aid skills.	90mins + Tutor support
Fire safety	This training takes a close look at the most common causes of workplace fires and how to prevent them. It also covers the correct firefighting equipment to use and fire safety and evacuation procedures.	60mins + Tutor support
Food safety	The course will help you understand more about the importance of good food preparation. You'll learn about training and cooking practices such as keeping yourself and your work area clean and hygienic, how food becomes contaminated and steps to reduce this. You will also learn how food-borne, pest and physical contamination pose serious health risks and the controls to reduce these risk	60mins + Tutor support
Health and safety awareness	This training will give a summary of health and safety, welfare and environmental issues. Candidates will also be given the knowledge to identify individual responsibilities for looking after themselves and others, what the employer's duties are and what should be done if anyone's health and safety is being put at risk.	90mins + Tutor support

Infection prevention and control (Covid-19)	The infection control training course aims to help reduce the risk of spreading disease and infection in a care environment. A mandatory requirement for anyone working within the care industry. Cross infection and contamination can be controlled and the risk reduced through adopting best practice technique which we aim to teach during this training	120mins + Tutor support
Safeguarding (Isolation)	The aim of our Safeguarding Training is to provide the candidates with the knowledge and ability to identify and appropriately respond to abuse when it occurs, or is suspected within the community and the care sector.	150mins + Tutor support
Medication management	Using different medications and their classifications. Legislation and guidelines related to medication. Role of the worker and others in the medication process. How to access information about medication. How medications are supplied and obtained. Storing medication. Safe disposal of medication. Preparations to be take prior to administering medication. How to safely administer medication in ways that meet individual needs. Supporting individuals to administer their own medication. The procedures that should be followed when problems occur. How to monitor the effects of medication. Record keeping and audit process for medication	60mins + Tutor support
